Recap/Feedback



- Meeting was focused on roundtable discussions with each Mission Center managers to discuss progress, provide feedback/guidance on priorities, and identify opportunities for collaboration.
- Supportive of Mission center approaches, growth, and execution to date; encouraged by integration of DHS Component intelligence equities.
 - Encourage focus on ensuring mission centers develop standard procedures to ensure a common and consistent execution.
- Priority Focus Areas:
 - Enable collection opportunities by encouraging Mission Centers to identify, document, and share collection priorities.
 - Ensure development of common processes for sharing planned production topics/schedules, as well as finished products.
 - Increased role of deployed field personnel as the primary touchpoint for engagement and collaboration with mission centers;
 - L&A continue to increase its field presence to cover all fusion centers.
