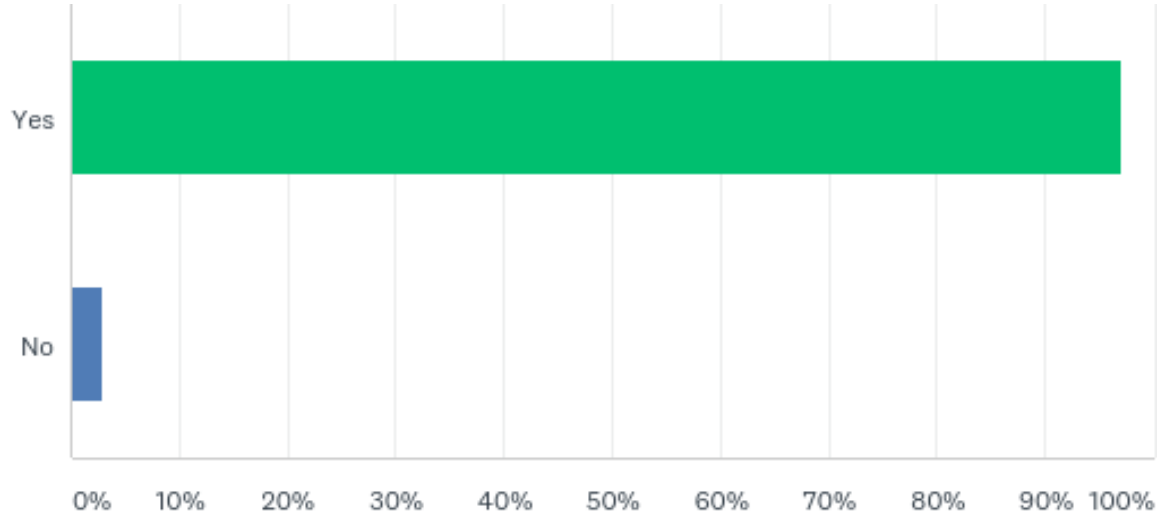

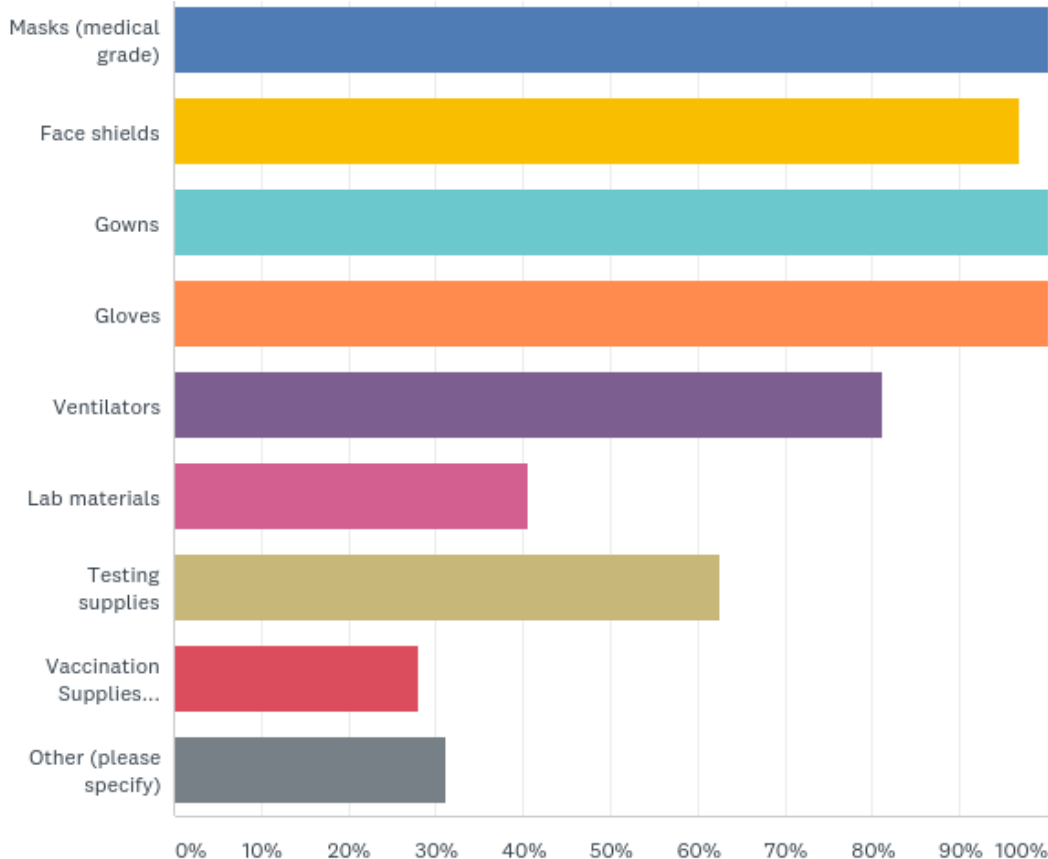
Is the state creating or maintaining a state-owned stockpile?

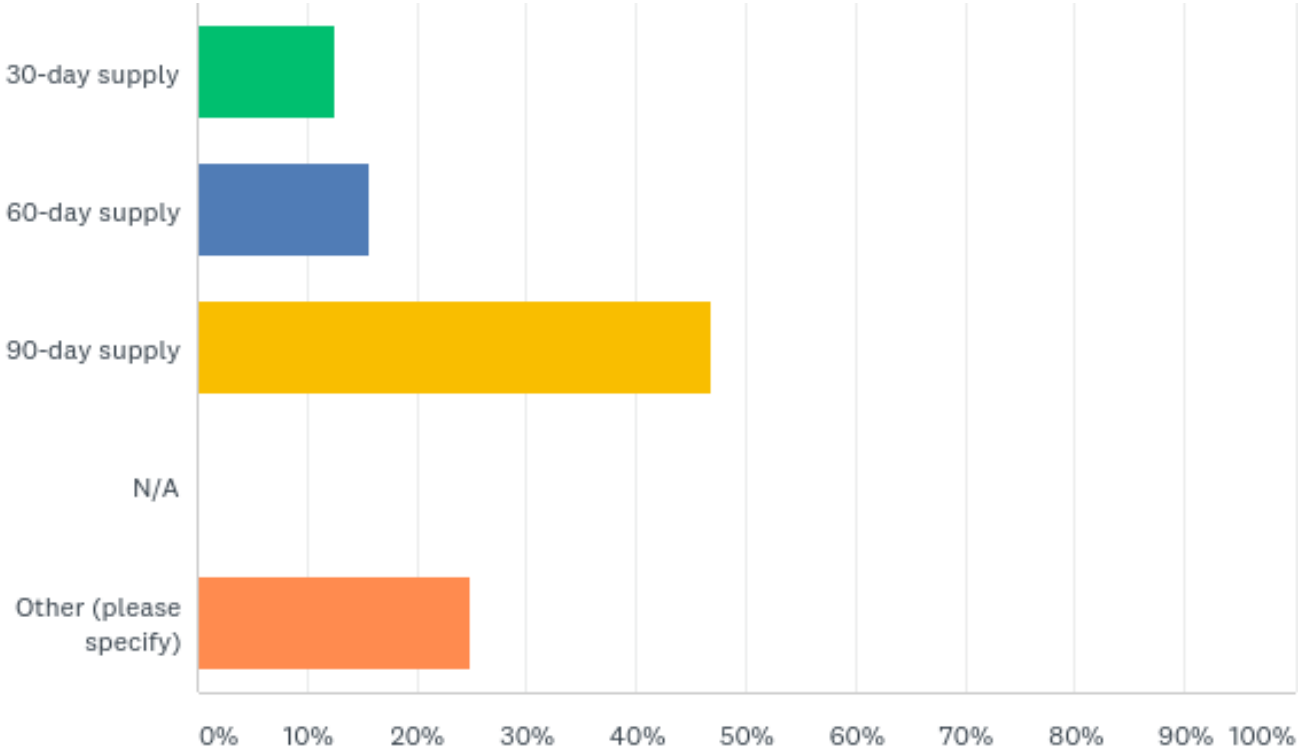

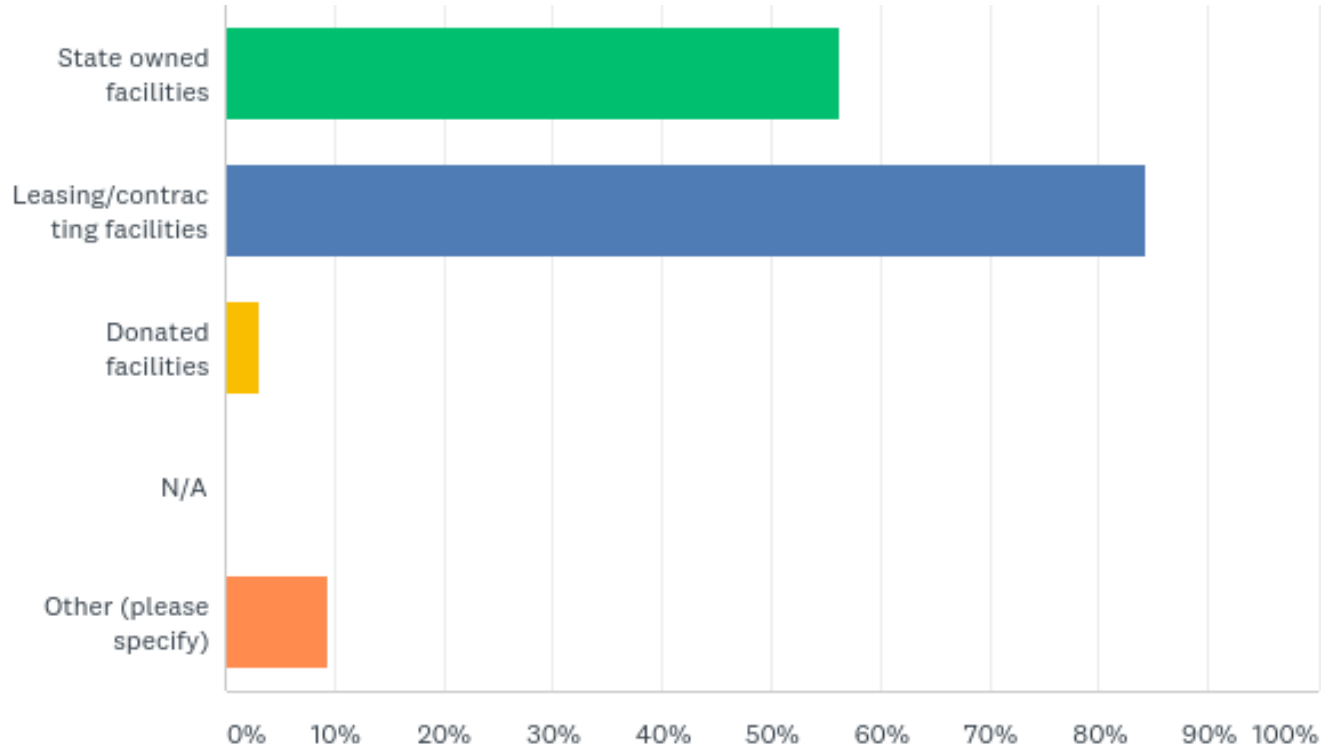

How much stock will the state plan out in the supply?



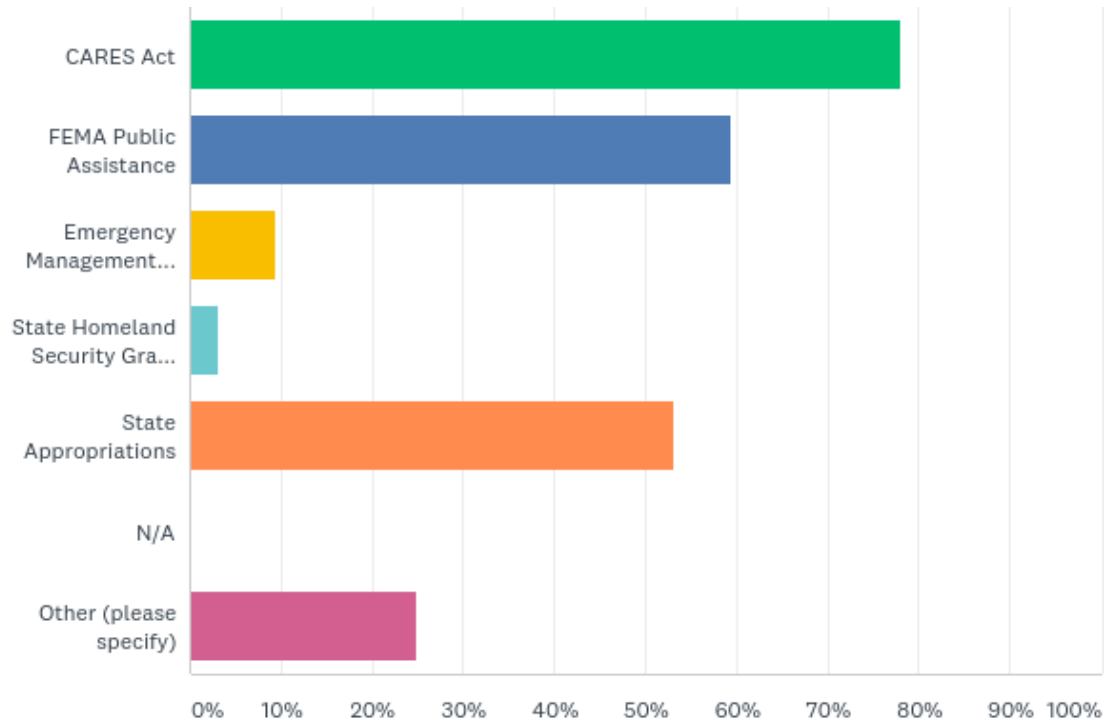

What warehouse facilities is the state using to store the stockpile?



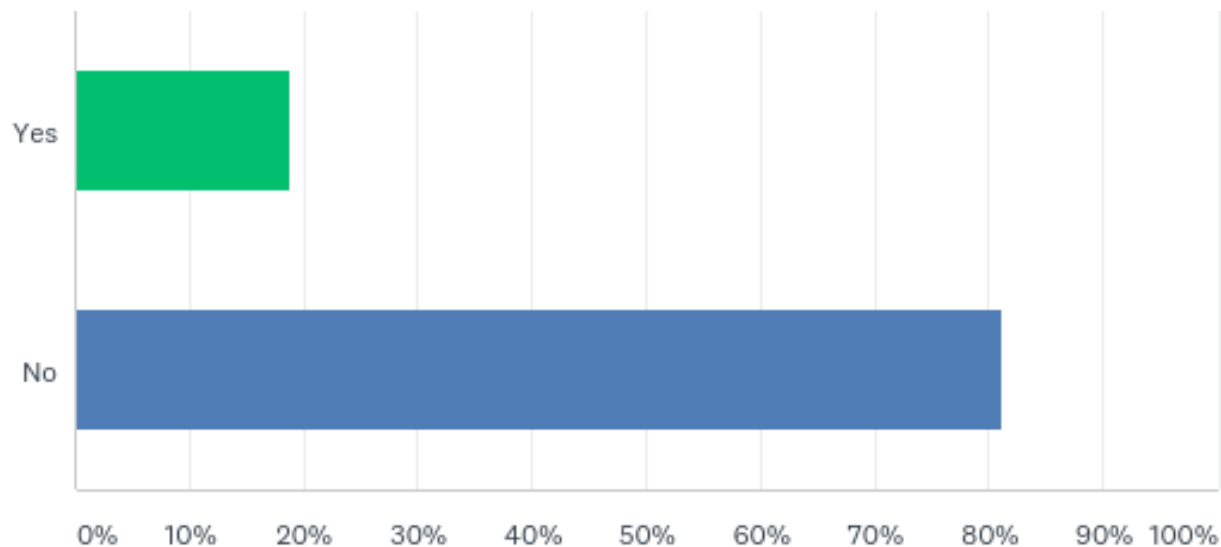

What funding source is the state using to procure the stockpile?

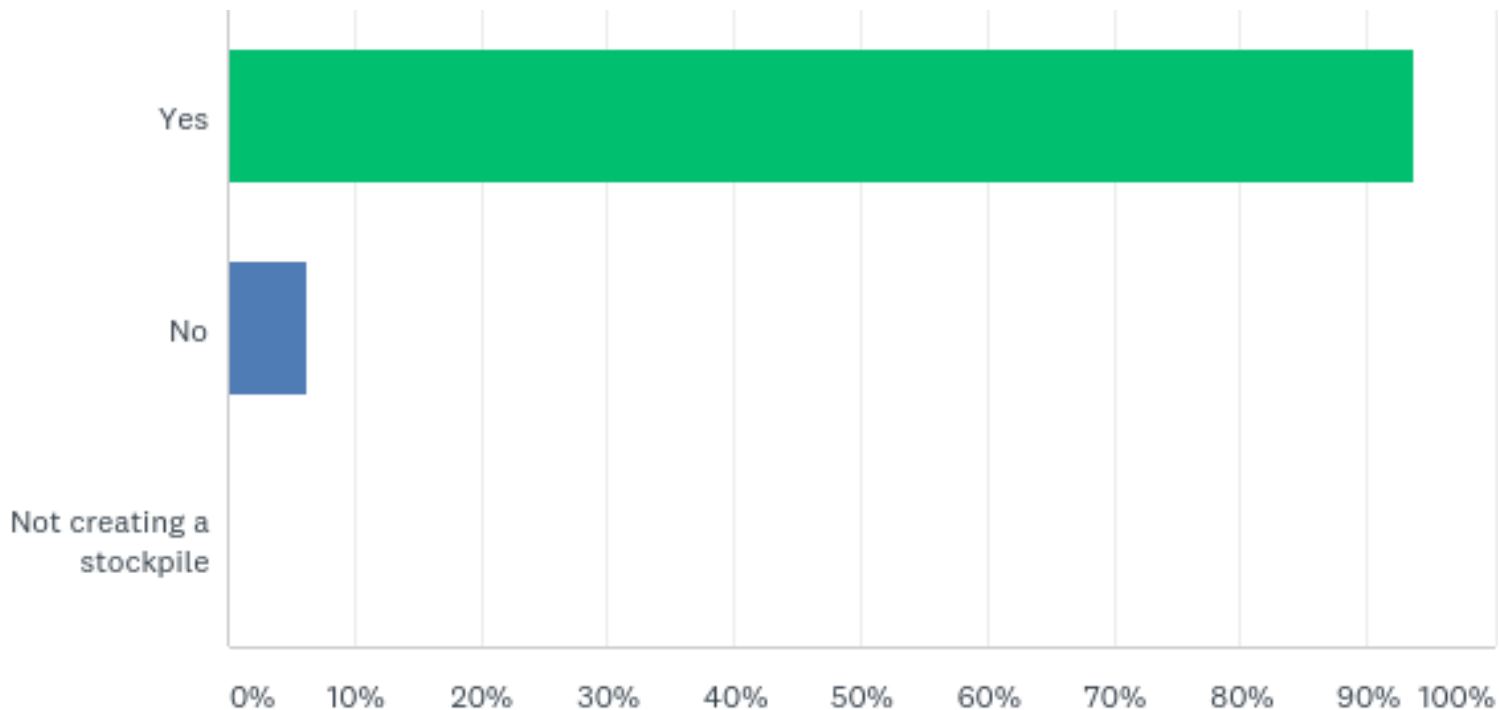

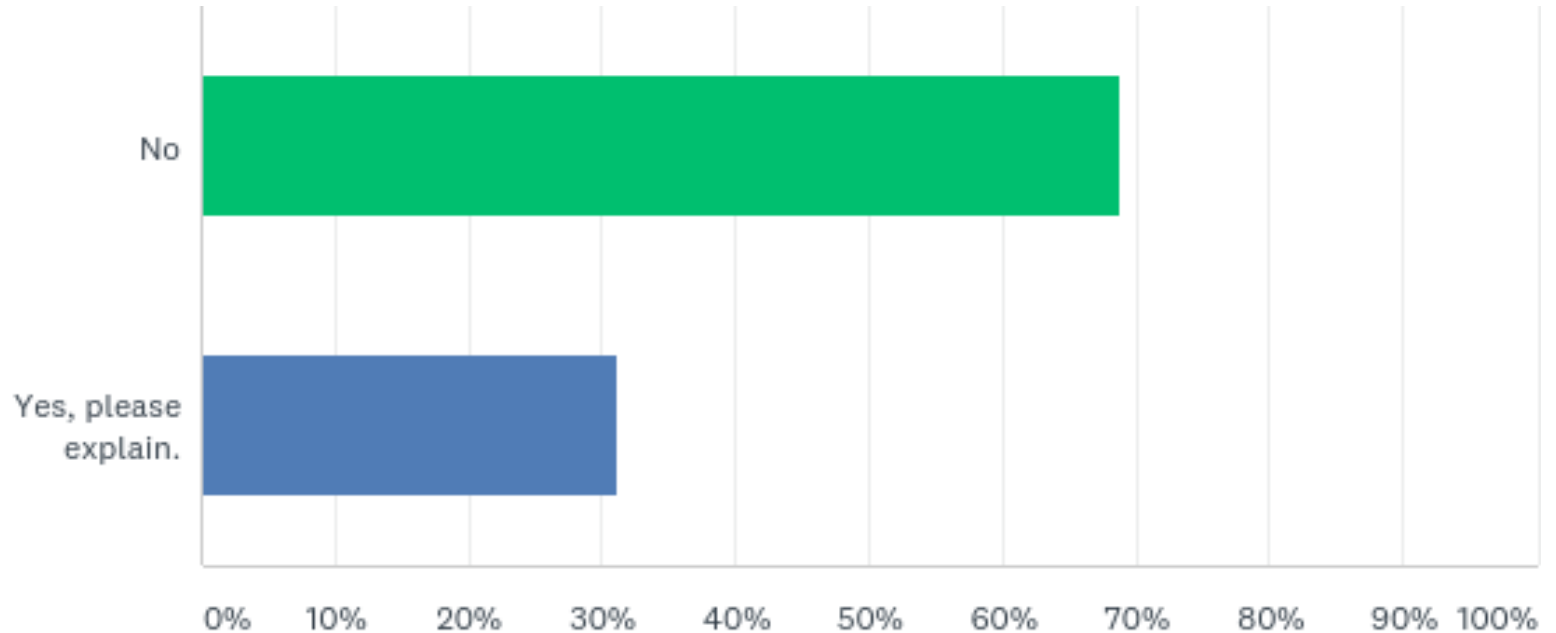
Is your state part of a region or consortium considering purchasing/stockpiling PPE to gain better pricing and perhaps share within the region?

Changes of the MCM Program

- During activation, MCM is under the operational control of the SEOC (traditionally under public health).
 - Procurement, distribution, or warehousing of PPE is moving from public health to other agencies as leads.
 - The emergency management role is elevated in the public health operation.
 - Public Health mindset is more operational based now than previously
 - Evolving structural changes: Once focused on vaccines, now more inclusive with the addition of other PPE
 - Increased need for on-hand inventories
 - Identified needs for a stockpile/warehouse operations
